

4th-6th Grade Class Descriptions

LANGUAGE ARTS

Grammar/Writing - Students will hone their writing skills through exercises and word games. They will learn to think out of the box by developing their skills through picture study, memorization, punctuation, spelling, poems, psalms, creative writing, and more.


BIBLE

The curriculum for this class will be ordered in bulk and supplied to each student at the cost of \$20 each.


SOCIAL STUDIES
